Intent of mass shooting against minorities and council members



Disrupted family, lack of job, bullying, active investigation against author





Lack of textual substance



Omission of explicit target (general reference):

"(...) rationalizing and explaining my hate towards <u>minorities</u>"

"I will be shooting every <u>minority</u> in sight" Authorship disguise



Spelling mistake in name of alleged author:

"Gaston Aaron Mcwhinnie" vs. 'Mc<u>W</u>hinnie'

Excessive spacing in between words on several occasions Opposing and redundant phrases



Constricting and unnecessary sentences:

"I fucking hate minorities. It's weird, since I'm black myself."

"I don't know how to start this letter."



TRAP-18 Indicators





Identification as shooter

"Today, on Sunday May 30, 2021, I will be heading out into different parts of Lakewood with my AR-15 and Glock 18, and I will be shooting every minority in sight. I am aiming for at least 10, but the more the better."





Planning and preparing attack

"At my house on my computer, you will find a 192 page manifesto, rationalizing and explaining my hate towards minorities."



Signals of desperation

"I don't see much of a future for myself, and I have an ongoing case, so I think I'm just going to end with a bang."



Occupational failures

• "I don't have a job, and there's not much meaning to my life."

Self-identified grievances

"I've been bullied every single time I've stepped on the street. My dad left us at a young age, and my mom kicks me out of the house often."



Interpersonal failures

"Hopefully I can make my useless life have some worth, even if it is at the end."
